









# RIVER PATHWAYS SUMMER INTERNSHIP OPPORTUNITIES River Pathways Field Intern

Audubon Arizona seeks motivated, energetic interns to assist with wildlife and habitat monitoring on the Bureau of Land Management's Agua Fria National Monument and other public lands. Interns will assist Audubon biologists conducting surveys for the Western Yellow-billed Cuckoo (*Coccyzus americanus*) to look into the birds' presence/absence, breeding behavior, and habitat preferences. Interns may also assist with data management, other conservation efforts, and educational programs at the Nina Mason Pulliam Rio Salado Audubon Center (3131 S Central Avenue, Phoenix, AZ 85040).

All training will be provided. Transportation between the Rio Salado Audubon Center and field sites will also be provided. Positions will last approximately 9 weeks, from mid June through early August and involve approximately 12-20 hours of work per week. Work schedules will be variable and will include some early morning and overnight work.

#### **Requirements:**


- 16 years of age or older (18 and over preferred)

- Commit for the entire length of the internship (June 11 August 10, approx. 12-20 hours/week. Unpaid time off permitted.)
