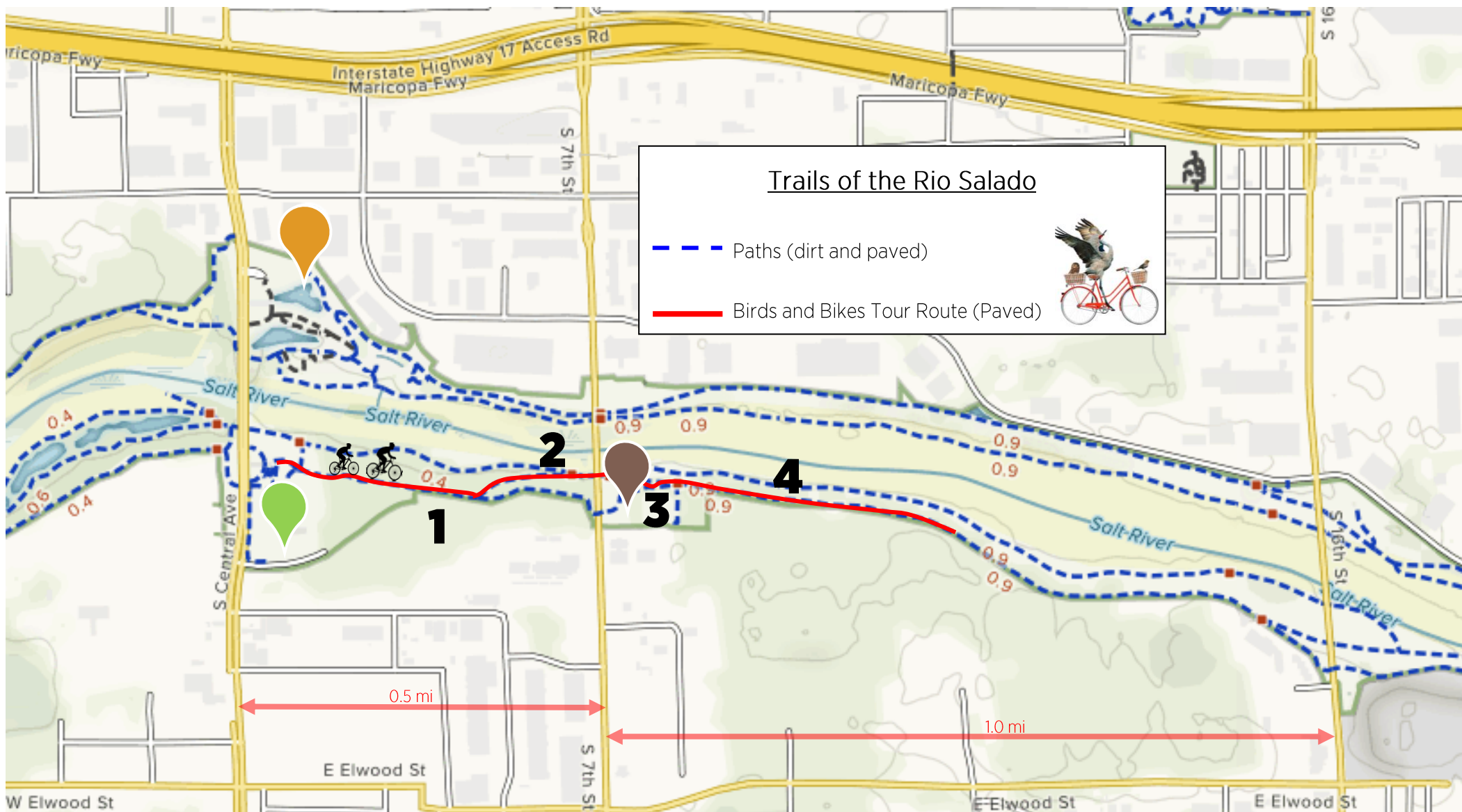

Directions

- Go north (towards downtown) from the Audubon center and take a right on the paved road headed east
- Proceed east along the paved path
- Go under the 7th St. bridge
- Ride up a slope to the restroom building
- Check out the pond area
- Keep to the paved path and look for burrowing owls and artificial burrows
- Go back to the Audubon Center the way you came
